Level of demand

said demand for services had 74% increased since the pandemic started. This is up from **59%** in Nov 2020 and 47% in May 2020.

A quarter of those who said demand 114 had increased said they had not been able to meet this demand.

of organisations said that they had to recruit additional staff to meet demand.

"The impact on most of our beneficiaries has been huge the support they need is greater and more complex." Survey respondent asnwer

"Our analysis of participant take up shows that low income families and those struggling with mental health are the last to return to activities." Survey respondent answer

Collaboration

Charitable organisations have pulled together during the pandemic with 40% saying they have collaborated with others more than they usually would.

Online and face-to-face service delivery

68% said they had moved part or all of their services online since the start of the pandemic with 60% of those who had. intending to continue to deliver services online.

When asked about whether there were barriers to returning to face-to-face services: 60% cited uncertainty around

COVID restrictions. 22% said space I location was no longer available.

"We will use a blended model because of some of the positive learning we have had but will revert some services to face-to-face" Survey respondent asnwer

"The pandemic has enabled us to work more smartly and use technology to serve some of our beneficiaries in ways that better suit them." Survey respondent answer

Confidence on short-term survival

76%

of respondents said their confidence of still being in operation by March 2022 was 100%.

Ths is an increase from 68% of respondents in Nov 2020 when asked about confidence of survival until March 2020
